Members are encouraged to report direct emissions from heating and use of fuel in facilities and assets, such as vehicles, that the company owns (scope 1), and electricity consumption (scope 2).

The CCCA's carbon certification scheme recognises the progress made by members to reduce their carbon footprint and contribute to Camden's overall aim of reducing the borough's emissions by 40% by 2020.
